Rain forests get their name because they are very wet. A lot of rain falls in these forests.

There are two kinds of rain forest: tropical and temperate.

Tropical rain forests have more plants and animals than any other ecosystem. Animals include birds, snakes, insects, jaguars, turtles, frogs, and many more.

The Amazon rain forest in South America is the biggest tropical rain forest in the world.

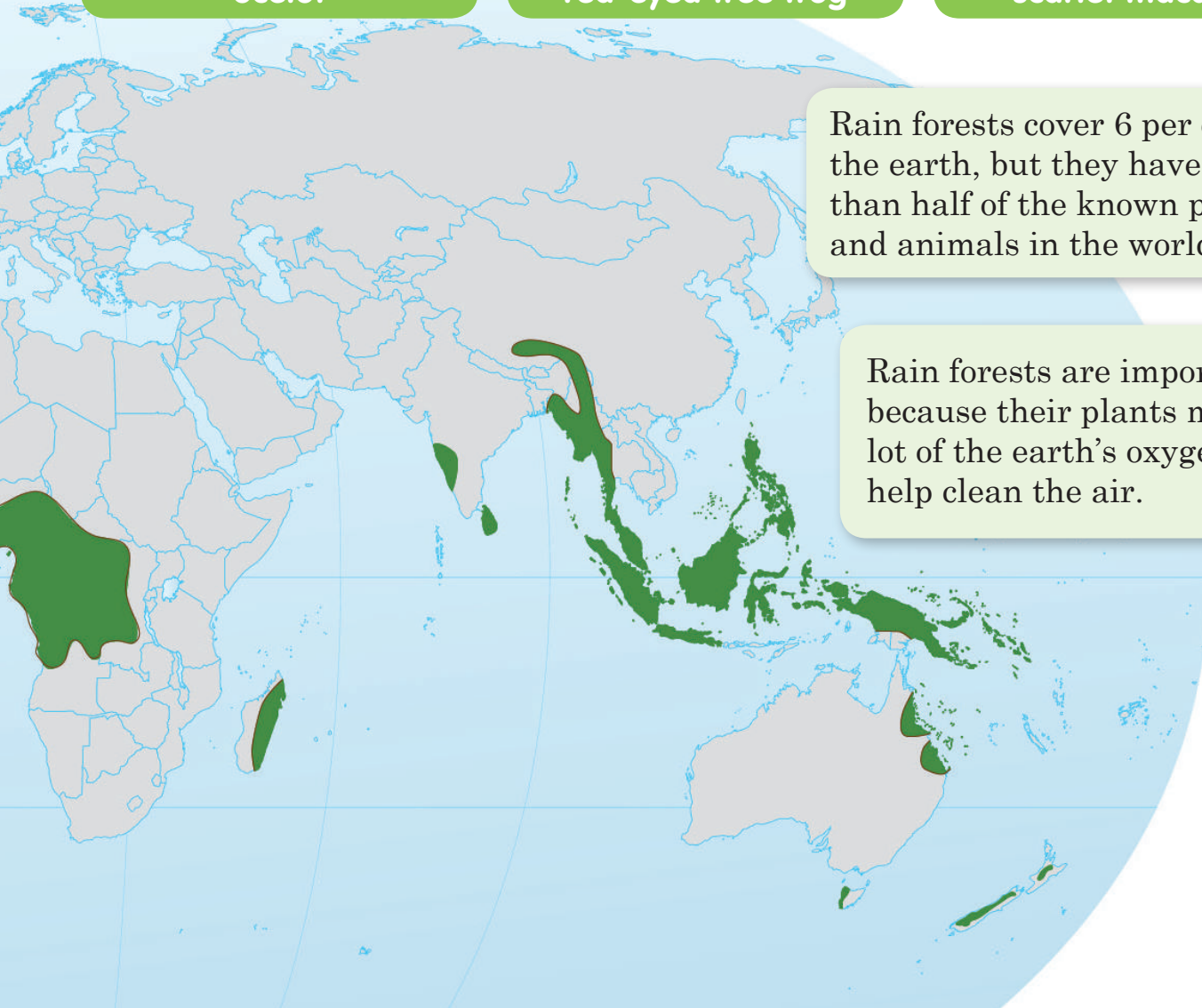
