


Going to South Africa

LIONS

Lions are large wild cats. They live in the savanna in Africa. A female lion is a lioness, and a baby lion is a cub. Male lions have a mane. They weigh about 180 kilograms. Lionesses are smaller, and they do not have a mane.

Lions usually live in groups called prides. They are loving toward each other and like to rub heads and groom each other. Lions are carnivorous, which means they eat meat. Their prev includes wildebeest and zebras. and sometimes hippos and giraffes.

Lions need a lot of sleep, up to twenty hours a dav. A lion's roar is loud, and you can hear it as far as eight kilometers away. Lions can run fast. They can also swim.

Lions live up to fifteen years in the wild. But now there are many dangers for lions, such as the loss of their habitat and hunters. Many lions now live in nature reserves.





Savannas are large areas of flat land covered in different kinds of grasses. A few trees and bushes grow there, too.

The largest savanna in the world is in Africa. Almost half of Africa is a savanna. Other large savannas are in South America, Australia, and India.

The grasses of savannas provide food for herds of large herbivores (plant eaters) like zebras, wildebeest, elephants, and giraffes.

The largest land animal, the elephant, and the tallest land animal, the giraffe, live on the African savanna.

















Many carnivores (meat eaters) like lions, cheetahs, leopards, and hyenas live in the savanna and hunt the herbivores that live there.

There are two seasons in the savanna: a dry season and a wet season. The rainy season is in summer, and the dry season is in winter.
